Possible ship anchorage: 64°51′50″S, 62°48′44″W

Located in northern Paradise Harbour



## **Key Features**

- Small, low elevation island surrounded by glaciers and ice
- · Scenic views.



## **Description**

#### **TOPOGRAPHY**

Low elevation, smooth granitic landing area leading up to flat, snow-covered area that is generally wildlife free.

# **Landing Requirements**

#### SHIPS'

Maximum passengers on board: 500

Ships per day: 3

\*A ship is defined as a vessel which carries more than 12 passengers.

#### **VISITOR NUMBERS**

Maximum of up to 100 persons onshore at one time (excluding guides).


#### **LANDING AREA**

Some large boulders that are easily navigated.

#### **VISITOR SAFETY**

Large waves from glacier calving and ice distribution could impact access to landing area.





# **Historical Information**

Likely named by whalers operating in the vicinity, as Leith, Scotland was the home of Salvesen and Company.
