**SOOSmap** brings together **internationally curated datasets** from decades of Southern Ocean observing into an **open-access**, **easy-to-use web interface**.

Quickly filter and sort datasets by a wide range of parameters, including time, data type, and geographical location using the powerful web map.

Currently, the map provides access to over 50 data layers from moorings, Argo floats, seal tag data, CPR Surveys, plastics observations, KrillBase data, penguin colony counts, and more.

It is delivered by EMODnet Physics with support of the SO-CHIC project and in collaboration with contributing data providers.








## Share and access planned routes to the Southern Ocean

**DueSouth** is a **free online database** that enables the Southern Ocean and Antarctic research community to share plans for upcoming cruises, expeditions and field campaigns.

Easily share your field plans and opportunities or start a collaboration by finding out who will be working near you, or who is working on similar research in other parts of the Southern Ocean.

The database includes upcoming voyages of National Antarctic Programs, international GO-SHIP transects, CCAMLR exploratory fishing expeditions and tourist cruises.

It is hosted by the European Polar Board in Polardex, an online, multi-stakeholder platform for polar logistics discovery and enhanced planning opportunities.
